**SKIING & SNOWBOARDING FOR CHILDREN & TEENS \***



**Kids' Group Lesson – Levels 2-9, Skiing, ages 7-12; Snowboarding, ages 8-12** → Offered Daily at Snowmass, Buttermilk and Aspen Highlands (levels 5-9) from 9:30am-3:15pm

Kids make friends and learn to ski and ride in a fun, supportive environment. A day at Kids' Camp means exploring all the coolest trails, visiting adventure zones, and building skills in the park & pipe. Highlights of the week include race days and Park & Pipe Day. Classes are divided according to age and ability and include a supervised lunch.

**Teens' Group Lesson – Levels 2-9, ages 13-17** → Offered Daily at Snowmass, Buttermilk and Aspen Highlands (levels 5-9) from 9:30am-3:15pm

Our Teens' "Too Cool for School" program is taught by our most qualified coaches. Teens explore the mountain, checking out all of the terrain, from the beginner areas and the easy groomers to the park & pipe and the bumps and steeps. Groups are formed by skill level and goals.

**Kids' & Teens' First Turns – Level 1, Skiing, ages 7-17; Snowboarding, ages 8-17** → Kids' class offered daily at Snowmass and Buttermilk, teens' class offered daily at Snowmass, 9:30 a.m.-3:15 p.m. Includes lift ticket, lesson and equipment rental voucher

**Snowmass Steep Camps – Levels 8-9, Skiing only, ages 12-19** → Offered at Snowmass, 4-day program: Monday – Thursday, 9:30 a.m.-3:15 p.m. on the following dates: Feb. 18-21, Mar. 12-15, March 17-20, March 24-27

These four-day camps are for advanced and expert skiers and are designed to teach kids and teens how to ski North America's toughest black and double-black diamond terrain in a fun, dynamic environment. Small groups stay together with the same pro for the week and are joined by some of the top freeskiing competitors.
